I. Games Overview

1. ABOUT MONGOLIA IN BRIEF

Name of Capital City: Ulaanbaatar, located roughly in the center of

Mongolia.

Population: 3,413 million

Average altitude: 1.580 m above sea-level **Climate:** Average summer temperature +20'C,

Average winter temperature -26'C,

Average rainfall 200 - 220 mm

Official language: Mongolian

Religions: Buddhism, Muslim, Christian and Shamanism

Currency: Tugrug (MNT), 3491.00₹ (MNT)= 1\$ (USD) by Jan 31, 2023.

Main entry points:

"Chinggis Khaan" International Airport (located in Tuv province), Sukhbaatar province (railway station on the Mongolian-Russian border)

and Zamiin Uud (railway station on the Mongolian-Chinese border)

Voltage: 220 volts/50 HZ

Food: Mongolians mostly eat cuisine consisting of various kinds of meat. "Chanasan makh" is boiled fatty meat (sheep, beef, goat) with salt and some vegetables. "Buuz" is large steamed dumplings and recipes are dough filled with sheep or beef with onion and garlic. "Aaruul" is dried curd with or without sugar. Mongolians like to eat aaruul as a snack. "Suutei Tsai" is traditional Mongolian tea with milk. "Chatsargana" is seabuckthorn juice that 100% natural and contains many vitamins and organic acids that boost the immune and digestion systems.

2. EAYG INTRODUCTION

The East Asian Youth Games (EAYG) is a continental multi-sport event held every four years among players from East Asian NOCs which are members of the East Asian Olympic Committees (EAOC). Ulaanbaatar is the city in the world to host the East Asian Youth Games for the first time.

3. SIGNIFICANCE



Organizing a multi-sport event, East Asian Youth Games, for the first time in Mongolia will contribute to spreading and promoting the ideals of Olympism /Olympic Value/, in compliance with the provisions contained in the Olympic Charter. And the fundamental principles are expressed in the Olympic Charter, and the Constitution and Rules of the Olympic Council of Asia are to be observed and safeguarded.

The mission of the East Asian Youth Games is to promote the development of sports, culture, education, and the spirit of fair play in sports competitions among young people in East Asia and build up the physical fitness of young generation in the region. Discover the young talented players in East Asia and strengthen the relationships between them and inspire them to participate in the Olympic Games in 2028 and 2032.

While promoting the Host city, Mongolian history, tradition, culture, and art will be introduced and advertised to the participating players and officials during the event.



4. EAYG EMBLEM



East Asian Youth Games

The design concept of the Ulaanbaatar 2023 East Asian Youth Games logo is inspired by the shape of the Toono which is one of the essential components of the traditional Mongolian Ger. The Toono firmly holds the walls together with Uni. It brings the sunlight down to the Ger, welcoming everyone inside to sit down together and converse.

Moreover, Toono and Uni together symbolize the sunlight, and if we imagine the Earth as a Ger, Mongolia is situated where the Toono is placed. Many people work together to set up the Toono. Therefore, our emblem represents the unity of participating athletes and representatives of East Asian National Olympic Committees under one roof.

Thus, let us come together under the Toono that our athletes have built - to showcase and exchange the culture, history, pride a love for sports as we all live and breathe under one Ger - Earth.

With our athletes coming from all parts and directions of majestic East Asia, we believe that their strength, will and achievements will help us create and hold a bright future together. Let us celebrate our love and respect for each other's culture, passion for sports and unity at the very first East Asian Youth Games in Ulaanbaatar in 2023.

5. ELIGIBILITY

The East Asian Youth Games are open to members of the East Asian Olympic Committees and the International Boxing Association (IBA) and Asian Boxing Confederation satisfying the following conditions:

Players born on 2005.01.01-2006.12.31 (17-18 years old)

Only athletes who comply with IBA and Asian Boxing Confederation Rules and Regulation and its bye-laws are entitled to participate in the Boxing competition.

6. ENTRY TIMELINE

Entries by Sport and Number shall be submitted to the Organizing Committee via the following email before the below-mentioned deadline. Email for registration: registration@ulaanbaatar2023.org

Entry by name should be submitted via e-system before the given deadline.

7. ENTRY POLICIES

Each NOC participating in the Boxing competition may enter maximum of one (1) athlete in each weight categories.

Additional Team delegations can be added to the team with extra charge in accommodation.

Maximum number of participants might be as follows:

Any NOC that withdraws its athletes or teams after the submission of the final entries by name or the Team Draw phase will be faced with disciplinary action by the EAOC.

8. COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The Boxing competition of the Ulaanbaatar 2023 East Asian Youth Games shall be played in accordance with the latest rules and regulations published by the International Boxing Association and Asian Boxing Confederation, in force during the Games time. All necessary interpretations will be made before the competition during the General Technical Meeting.

In case of any disagreement in the language interpretation of the rules and regulations, the English version of the Rules and Regulations of International Boxing Association and the Asian Boxing Confederation shall prevail.

Any unforeseen cases not covered by regulations and rules shall be resolved as follows:

- General issues: Resolved in accordance with Constitution the East Asian Olympic Committees;
- Technical issues: Resolved in accordance with the IBA and ABC Rules and Regulations.

9. COMPETITION FORMAT

The competition will be held through single elimination system. This means that, for all categories, progressive rounds will be held with the loser of each bout automatically being eliminated.

This will continue until two boxers are left to box for the gold medal round. Two bronze medals will be awarded to the losers of the semifinals in each event/weight category.

In Men's and Women's competitions, the Bouts must consist of 3 (three) rounds of three (3) minutes each. One (1) minute break must be taken between rounds in accordance with the AIBA Technical Rules and AOB Competition Rules.

10. DAILY MEDICAL EXAMINATION AND WEIGH-IN

The daily medical checkup and weigh in shall be held at 07:00AM - 08:00AM on August 17th to August 22nd of 2023 at the Competition Venue.

11. TECHNICAL MEETING

Date: 16th of August 2023 Time and Place: TBD

12. PROTESTS / APPEALS

Appeals should be made by the Player or their Team Manager only to the Referee. If a Referee maintains his or her decision, the complaint shall be referred to the Technical Delegate. The decision of the Technical Delegate will be final.



13. EQUIPMENT AND UNIFORMS

Equipment used and clothing worn by athletes and other relevant participants in competition must comply with the rules and regulations of the UEAYGOC-2023 and IBA in force.

Neither athletes nor technical officials can attach any form of commercial advertising to his or her competition uniform without prior agreement with the UEAYGOC.

14. DOPING CONTROL AND MEDICAL

Doping Control during the Games will be conducted in accordance with EAOC Medical Committee instructions applicable to the East Asian Youth Games and will follow the standards and procedures specified by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).

UEAYGOC, in collaboration with the EAOC Medical Committee, will assist with the investigation of any case where sex determination is required, should the need arise. The need for such tests and processes will be followed as per the rules and procedures laid down by EAOC.

EAOC-regulated medical care and an ambulance will be provided at all venues and sites.

Basic medical and on-site emergency services will be provided free of charge at the venues and residential zones. While the costs incurred by medical treatment in the hospital, emergency referral, follow-up treatment and other medical services shall be borne by the patients themselves.

All team delegations are recommended to take out their own liability and medical insurance.

15. AWARDS CEREMONY

Gold, silver and two bronze medals will be awarded to the athletes ranked top four of each event respectively.

Before the Awards Ceremony starts, the players shall be escorted to the Waiting Area to get ready for the ceremony. The awardees must wear their official uniforms/designated sports attire during the award ceremony.

16. MEDIA INTERVIEW

All players should pass through the Mixed Zone. Players and/or coaches should attend press conferences and interviews when there are interview requests for them. It is prohibited for anyone to take the players who has just finished the competition to any place other than the mixed zone and interview room.

17. VISA

For those who would need a visa to enter Mongolia, the Organizing Committee will provide related information in advance respectively.



18. TRANSPORTATION

Free transportation will be provided for arriving and departing players and team officials, depending on arrival and departure information and flight schedule. From hotel to the venue and back will be arranged according to the Competition schedule respectively.

19. ACCOMMODATION

During the Games, all athletes and officials, including extra officials will be accommodated at the dedicated hotel

20. SPORT INFORMATION CENTER

All sport-specific information for the competition will be available at the sport information desks. They are located at the competition venue and at the Sports Information Center (SIC) in the Athletes' Hotel.
