












1. ORGANIZER

3.1. Participating Boxers

- U15 Boys & Girls boxers between the age of 13 and 14 according to their year of birth (born between 2011 2012) will be eligible to compete in the following categories:
 30-33kg, 35kg, 37kg, 40kg, 43kg 46kg, 49kg, 52kg, 55kg, 58kg, 61kg, 64kg, 67kg, 70kg, +70kg.
- U17 Boys & Girls boxers between the age of 15 and 16 according to their year of birth (born between 2009 2010) will be eligible to compete in the following categories:
 44kg 46kg, 48kg, 50kg, 52kg, 54kg, 57kg, 60kg, 63kg, 66kg, 70kg, 75kg, 80kg and +80kg.
- Reserve Boxers: If your National Federation is hesitating between 2 boxers, or simply wants to prevent any injury, please register the "Reserve boxer" on the registration form. This function will allow you to register more than one boxer in the same category, and you will have the possibility to choose last minute which boxer will participate even after registration ended (only one boxer will be allowed to compete in each category)



11-25 Boxers:	Up to 12 Coaches

3.3 Coaches and R&J s

Each Boxer will be entitled to be accompanied to the ring by up to three (3) Coaches.- Only two (2) Coaches may mount the apron of the ring and only one (1) may enter the ring.

- All boxers must be accompanied by at least one World Boxing certified coach at ringside during the bouts.
- All Coaches allowed to work in the Field of Play (FOP) must be World Boxing certified .
- If any team does not have a certified coach, please raise this at the Technical Meeting so arrangements can be made with another team.
- Any coach of National Level, who has not World Boxing certified, will not be allowed to enter the FOP.
- All R&J's will be nominated by their respective National Federations and the final approval will be granted by Asian Boxing.
- The R&J's nominated by NF should be World Boxing certified The respective National Federations will pay the airfare for the approved RJ's and the LOC will provide transportation to venue, accommodation and per diem.




The room rates includes:

- There will be five (5) Judges for each bout in accordance with electronic draw by Scoring System.

10. SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

10.1 All boxers must bring the following items to the sports entries check:

- Boxer's Passports
- Boxer's International Record Books
- Boxer's World Boxing Medical Certificate (Issued within the last 3 months)
- Video consent form
- Image rights consent form
- Uniform and robe (if applicable)

10.2 Each team Delegation must also bring the following:

- National Flag 1X1.5 m
- National Anthem on USB Drive/CD in .mp3 format.

10.3 Boxer's Uniform:

- The vest and shorts/skirt can be in the Boxer's respective national colours or in red or blue colour according to the Boxer's respective corner allocation
- Women Boxers may wear a black sport form-fitting Hijab
- The belt line of any shorts/ skirts must be clearly indicated by a contrasting color and by using a 6.10cm wide elastic waistband (The belt line is an imaginary line from the navel to the top of the hips.)
- Bring Hair net/ bandanna (for boxers with long hair)
